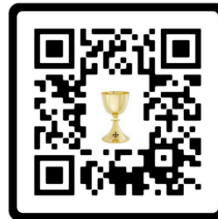
Our next blood drive will be Sunday, November 6th, 2022. Please share this with your family and friends and come give the gift of life.
